

Karuizawa Club of Art “Piano Master Class” Application Guidelines

1. Purpose: The Karuizawa Club of Art, a lodging and training facility located in Karuizawa, one of the most popular summer resorts in Japan, will hold a “Piano Master Class” to provide a space for learning music and a place for musicians to study and interact with each other.
2. Period: Saturday, August 24, 2024 – Tuesday, August 27, 2024
Please check out by the morning of the following day, Wednesday, August 28.
If you wish, you can come in the day before. Please consult with us.
3. Venue: Karuizawa Club of Art
3607-1 Nagakura, Karuizawa-cho, Kitasaku-gun, Nagano, 389-0111, Japan
Accommodations and meals will be provided at the Karuizawa Club of Art, the venue for the event.
If you wish to bring a companion, please contact us.
4. Eligibility: Students studying classical music, no restrictions on professional or amateur status, no musical background, no age requirement.
5. Songs for the course: Any music that can be defined as classical music is acceptable. (The number of pieces is also free, as long as the lesson time permits. (The number of pieces may be as long as the lesson time permits.)
6. Lesson: You will have 2 to 3 one-on-one lessons (50 minutes) with the instructor (may vary depending on the number of participants). (This may vary depending on the number of participants.) In principle, the music selections will be those declared on the application form. In addition, there will be a special lecture for all participants. On the last day, a commemorative concert will be given by the lecturers and participants.

9. Maximum number of students: Approximately 15 students.

10. How to apply: Please apply using the entry form on the Karuizawa Art Club Piano Master Class website.

If the number of applicants exceeds the maximum number, participants will be selected by lottery.

Application deadline: Wednesday, July 31, 2024

11. Flow after application: After submitting the entry form, you will receive information on where to transfer the application fee. At that time, you will be asked to transfer a portion of the course fee (10,000 yen). The application will be considered complete upon partial payment of the course fee. After confirming your application, we will contact you by e-mail with information on how to transfer the rest of the course fee, instructions for the day of the course, cancellation policy, etc.

12. Cancellation Policy If you wish to cancel your attendance after submitting your application, please contact us via the contact form on the website or by e-mail. The date of cancellation will be the date of your request.

Until August 1: No cancellation fee is required. The application fee will be refunded.

Until August 15: 50% of the cancellation fee will be charged.

After August 16: 100% cancellation fee will be charged.

Bank transfer charges for refunds will be borne by the applicant.

13. other

If the entry form is incomplete, we may not be able to accept your application.

If you do not fill out the entry form, you may not be able to take the course. Please be sure to fill out the entry form.

In principle, participants are required to attend all the lessons.

In principle, lessons will be open to the public. (Some lessons may be private.) Public lessons will be open to all participants.

(Some lessons will be private lessons.) Public lessons will be free for students to attend. Please understand this in advance.

Public lessons will be simultaneously broadcasted to the Japan Art Center (Kobe City, Hyogo Prefecture).

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Piano practice rooms and other facilities are available for students to use free of charge. Students may use these rooms free of charge. (Rooms are limited, so please share with other students.)

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The commemorative concert on the last day is free of charge for students and 2,000 yen for the general public.

The commemorative concert will be simultaneously broadcasted to the Japan Art Center (Kobe City, Hyogo Prefecture).
