4. Eligibility

Over 15 years old

5.Selection

Preliminary review (Sound source review by MP3 data)

Applicants must record his or her performance listed below I, II on a MP3 data. Total performance duration is approximately 15 minutes.

- I .One piece from Paganini; 24 Caprices Op.1
- II .Solo piece of the Applicant's choice
- To be performed in the order of $I \rightarrow II$

Preliminary round

Contestants must perform same repertoires as Preliminary review. Total performance duration is approximately 15 minutes.

• To be performed in the order of $I \rightarrow II$

Second round

Contestants shall play free program. Total performance duration is approximately 25 minutes.

Final round

Contestants shall play free program. Total performance duration is approximately 40 minutes.

%Notice

- · Repertoire pieces' copyrights must be already expired.
- Piano accompaniment is acceptable. Contestants must arrange pianists and pageturner themselves.
- MP3 data shall not have extremely loud or quiet sounds volume, and shall not contains noises. The recording must be made in or after March 2025. To be performed in the order of $\,\mathrm{I}\to\mathrm{II}$
- Contestants must perform different pieces between Preliminary round and Final round. Different movements shall be considered as a same piece.

Generally, change of program shall not be acceptable.

6. Judging

The competition will be judged by a panel of judges selected from the general public. The information of the jury members will not be made public during the Competition. The Contestant's name, educational background, position, and other information will not be given to the jury. The jury will use the Contestant's entry number. The number of jury members is subject to change.
